



FunderFinder software : prices, definitions etc

If you buy our software there are two elements to consider:

- A one-off licence fee - this is a licence to run the software
- The annual renewal fee - which covers new data, support etc. If the data is too old (in other words, you don't pay the annual renewal fee), after a while the software stops working. You are first invoiced for the annual renewal fee 12 months after you buy the licence.

Sites: You do not necessarily need a site licence for each computer you install our software on. You might have a single site licence but install the software on a network or on an office computer and a laptop you take out. What matters is usage. - e.g. if it is likely to be used by two different people at the same time, you need a licence for 2 sites (and so on). If you have physically distinct offices, you need (at least) a licence for each office.

PIN

PIN keeps track of charities that fund individuals - for education or social need.

The cost of a single (or first) site licence for PIN is £100 plus VAT. The annual renewal fee for that site is £30 plus VAT. If you buy a licence for more than one site, the per site cost reduces.

GIN

GIN keeps track of charitable trusts that fund voluntary/community organisations.

The cost of a single (or first) site licence for GIN is £150 plus VAT. The annual renewal fee for that site is £75 plus VAT. If you buy a licence for more than one site, the per site cost reduces.

RESTRICTIONS

We won't sell PIN at all to organisations that want to charge for its use.

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

A computer running Windows 98 or higher. Any such computer is likely to have sufficient RAM to run GIN and/or PIN but contact us if you think there might be a problem. Free disk space necessary for GIN is 30MB and for PIN 50MB.

APPLY YOURSELVES helps voluntary and community groups write effective funding applications. Use it to draft a letter or proposal to funders. BUDGET YOURSELVES helps voluntary and community groups write effective budgets. It provides lots of advice about the process of making a budget, things that might need to go in it, and how to work out accurate costs. Use it to link budgets and to compare actual income and expenditure with your budget figures. It does the calculating, so if you change any of the figures, your budget will still add up.
