Apart from charitable trusts and companies there are a lot of other bodies that it might be worth approaching. It depends on who you are, who you know, and what you're trying to do.

Think about :

- Rotary, Lions, Round Table and similar groups
- Women's groups - Townswomen's Guild, Housewife's Register, WI
- Trades Unions and Trades Clubs
- Chamber of Commerce
- Student Union
- Faith bodies



Local development agencies (like councils for voluntary service and rural community councils) should be able to help with some names and addresses. Otherwise use the phone book and your local reference library. There are directories of all sorts that may be relevant.

Other things you can do to find out which organisations might be worth approaching:

- Look at other groups' annual reports to see who supports them.
- Look at the local newspaper to see who is in the photographs handing over the cheques.
